SPEAKING OF GOLF OUTINGS

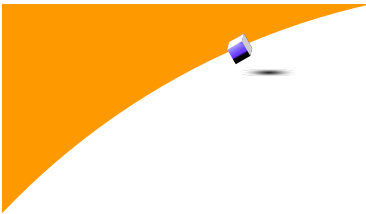
For our golfers, here is another golf outing you might be interested in.

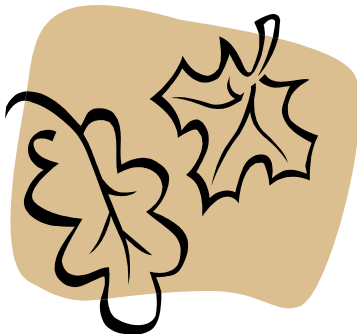
